Families First Coronavirus Response Act

Provides payroll tax credits for small and midsized businesses to offset the cost of providing coronavirus-related leave to employees. https://www.irs.gov/coronavirus



Economic Injury Disaster Loan

Apply directly. Up to \$2 million, 3.75% interest for working capital, 30-year term, no fees. Need based, estimated losses determine loan amount. Emergency grant advances of \$10,000 may be available.* https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela/

7A Loan - Paycheck Protection Program*

Up to \$10 million, max. 4% interest; for operating expenses; fees waived. Eligible expenses for first eight weeks following origination may be forgiven.*

Express Loan

Up to \$1 million, max 4% interest; for operating expenses; fees waived. Eligible expenses February 15-June 30, 2020 may be forgiven.*
