

IRRIGATION SEASON

Pressurized irrigation season:

- Starts and Ends: April – October depending on the season
- Backflow assembly testing for irrigation systems that use the City of Meridian's potable water are scheduled for the months of 05/01, 06/01, 07/01
- Customers can schedule with a licensed backflow tester to have their backflow preventer tested
- Test reports can be emailed to backflow@meridiancity.org
 - Passed reports – within 10 business days
 - Failed reports – within 2 business days

Dual Connections:

- Not allowed in the City of Meridian for residential use
- Dual Connection / Cross Connection:
 - Any actual potential connection between a potable water supply and any source of non-potable substance, through which it is possible to introduce non-potable, used, unclear, contaminated water or other substance into the potable water supply

Sprinkler Blow out and Winterization:

- Sprinkler pipes and backflow assemblies are at risk of freezing and breaking when temperatures drop below 32 degrees Fahrenheit
- Blowing out your sprinkler system and winterizing your backflow preventer will help to prevent water from freezing in your pipes and causing damage
- To be on the safe side the best time to blowout your sprinkler system is before October 31st
